You should bring the following items to the exam:

- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers)
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and free-response questions
- A sweatshirt in case you get cold
- A calculator if you're taking the exam for AP Calculus, Statistics, Chemistry, Biology, or Physics. Visit www.collegeboard.com/apstudents to learn more about the calculator policy for each of these exams. Bring extra batteries for your calculator. We cannot be responsible for dead batteries or calculator malfunction during the test session.

You should not bring the following to the exam:

- Cell phones, iPads or iPods. Any electronics brought to the testing room will be collected and returned after the test.
- Books, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets).
- Watches that beep or have an alarm.
- Cameras
- Ear plugs
- Clothing with subject-related information (don't print the answers on your shirt)

If you have an AM test, report directly to the testing room. We will take attendance during the test.

The cafeteria will be open for you to get lunch when your AM test is complete. We want nothing to get in the way of you doing your best on the AP exam. Students taking afternoon tests (Econ, Statistics, Physics) may eat lunch early (11:10) on test day before you come to the testing room.

Several students are taking two AP tests in one day and have noticed that the AM and PM times will overlap. In order to accommodate for their needs, we will release them ASAP from their AM tests (while we collect materials), and wait for them to return from lunch before starting the timers for the afternoon test. We can truncate the afternoon general instructions for those individual students in order to allow them time for lunch.

Teachers and staff members are aware of the fact that you will be missing class to take your AP test. Plan on being there for all of the scheduled test time. You may not be dismissed until the exam has officially ended. If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP obligation. Arrangements need to be made in advance so AP can take priority on test day. Plan for afternoon transportation home if your exam runs beyond the normal school day.

Please arrive on time for your exam. You will not be admitted into the test room after the test has started. If needed, make a plan to call your classmates to make sure they are awake and ready for the exam. Get a good night of rest before your test, and eat a nutritious breakfast. You are allowed to bring a snack and beverage for your 10-minute break. Eating is prohibited while you are taking an exam. It may be wise to dress in layers, in case the temperature is too warm or too cold for you.

You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and East Ridge High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP exam score. There will be no refunds for tests you have registered for but choose not to take. In fact, the College Board charges \$15 extra for any exams returned unused. If a late testing session is necessary (due to illness), a doctor's note will be required in order to have a late test ordered.
