Essential Question:

Service Learning Requirements:

- **5 Stages of service learning**
 - Inventory and Investigation: What needs do I see?
 - Preparation and Planning: What can I do to help?
 - Action: Take the time to make a difference!
 - Reflection: What did others gain from my service? What did I gain from my service?
 - Demonstration: Show (and inspire) others what you have accomplished.

- 3 Deadlines per year
 - November 14th
 - February 27th
 - May 29th

- Hours may be gained through Key Club membership, through AVID organized events such as serving at Dorothy Day homeless shelter, or scheduled independently.
 - If a Key Club Member, please adhere to all Key Club requirements and guidelines.
 - If scheduled independently, please fill out the attached form and turn in to AVID teacher for PRIOR approval. Hours should be signed off on by an adult in charge of the organization with which you are serving.

- Inventory & Investigation
Project/Organization Selection: Your choice of where to spend your time volunteering should . . .
 - Be realistic for your family/personal calendar and transportation needs.
 - Represent a true need you feel strongly about or which connects to your future goals.
 - Be a place or a situation in which you explore how you can make a difference.

- Preparation & Planning
 - What specifically will I do to help?

- Ongoing Reflection: What have others gained from my efforts? What have I gained by serving? Keep a log and reflection in which you will . . .
 - Describe what happened
 - Examine differences made
 - Discuss thoughts and feeling
 - Consider improvements

- Demonstration in AVID:
 - Report to peers, AVID teacher, and/or parents & community members
 - Write articles or letters to local newspapers
 - Create a web site
 - Make presentations or performances
 - Create displays of public art
 - Write a book
