

Start Your College Search

1. Visit colleges over the summer! Sophomores and juniors should be visiting colleges they are interested in attending. The Counseling Office has information and tips on how to make your campus visits successful.
2. Talk with college reps who visit East Ridge! College representatives visit with students in the Counseling Office. Visits from college reps are advertised on the [ERHS website](#), on the monitor and the bulletin board outside the Counseling Office, and morning announcements. Students interested in participating in college visits should sign up on *Naviance*. Please take advantage of these visits. Some college reps hold sessions open to anyone at sites other than East Ridge. Watch the college visit list on the College Resources page on the ERHS/Counseling website.
3. Go to a College Fair! There is a major College Fair at the Minneapolis Convention Center in October each year. There are smaller fairs in other times of the year.
