1 - Read and complete this form. Return it to the counseling office.

2 - Go to www.northernstaronline.org and follow the directions to register for the class.

3 - Make sure you understand the requirements for the class you are choosing.

4 - Your parent/guardian needs to approve the course online.

5 - Once the class is approved and your schedule is changed, you can start the online course.

- When taking an online course, your ERHS schedule needs to be reduced.
- The online course(s) you enroll in will take the place of the ER course being dropped.
- You will be dropped by NSO from your online course if you do not work in the class regularly. If you are dropped, you will receive a W/F (withdrawal/fail) on your ERHS transcript.
- The grade you receive in your online course will be put on your high school transcript and calculated in your GPA.
- You must speak to your counselor if you are considering withdrawing from your online course.
- Students that are successful online are able to manage their time well. It is your responsibility to stay on track and complete the class on time.
- If you are planning on playing sports in college and need to be NCAA eligible, please make sure that the course/s are NCAA approved. This information is on the NSO website.
- During the hour of your online course, students are expected to be off campus or in the media center.
- Seniors who take an online class during trimester three will have an early deadline to complete their course to accommodate obtaining course final grade for graduation. If students do not meet their NSO deadline it is not guaranteed that they will be able to participate in graduation.
- Students can elect to take online classes at their own cost during the summer or as an additional class to the six-period day.
